The Class Teacher will:

- Support initiatives decided by the Headteacher and Leadership Staff;
- Set high expectations which inspire, motivate and challenge pupils;
- Plan appropriately to meet the needs of all pupils, through a range of tasks;
- Be able to set clear targets, based on prior attainment, for pupils' learning;
- Provide a stimulating classroom environment, where resources can be accessed appropriately by all pupils;
- Keep appropriate and efficient records, integrating formative and summative assessment into planning;
- Work with Academy leaders to track the progress of individual children and intervene where pupils are not making progress;
- Report to parents on the development, progress and attainment of pupils;
- Promote the Academy's code of conduct amongst pupils, in accordance with the behaviour policy;
- Participate in meetings which relate to the Academy's management, curriculum, administration or organisation;
- Communicate and co-operate with specialists from outside agencies;



- Make effective use of ICT to enhance learning and teaching
- Lead, organise and direct support staff within the classroom;
- Participate in the performance management system for the appraisal of their own performance, or that of other staff.
